

Wolsey Hall Oxford Course Fees for Examination Years New Students: AS / A level

Included in your Wolsey Hall course

Each full A Level course covers curriculum content equivalent to two academic years of study and is designed to be studied over two academic years. These courses have a maximum 24-month access term, which is agreed on enrolment and which ends when the examinations have been taken on the selected exam date.

Each AS course covers curriculum content equivalent to one academic year of study and is designed to be studied over one academic year. These courses have a maximum 12-month access term which is agreed on enrolment and which ends when examinations have been taken on the selected exam date.

All our course fees include any course textbooks or e-books, access to online learning materials and subscriptions, as well as access to some free Wolsey Hall courses and guides. Transcripts and references are available as a supplementary paid service to support applications to universities and colleges. You will be allocated a Student Progress Manager to support you on your journey, in conjunction with your allocated Tutors who will provide periodic feedback on progress, and be available via our messaging system on our learning platform.

In addition, you have access to the Wolsey Hall Community area, Clubs, the Virtual Library and the Secondary Student Forum (age-dependent).

How our course fees work

We offer course bundles so the more subjects a student enrols on, the lower the cost of each course. It is possible to study at different examination levels within the IGCSE and A levels phases (this does not include enrolling on the same subject at different levels at the same time), if the entry criteria are met.

The tables on the next page outline these bundle fees. To find the price per course, use the column that represents the total number of courses that your child will be enrolling on now for this academic year, e.g. if your child is enrolling on 3 courses at A level, please use the "3 A levels" row to see the course prices.

Additional benefits

We offer a 10% discount to the sibling of a new or current student of Wolsey Hall. The first student from a family enrolled with Wolsey Hall will not receive a sibling discount.

The fees shown on the following pages are for payment in full and they include a discount of approximately 5%. If you wish to pay by instalment, please indicate this when you request a quote. You will then make an initial payment followed by six consecutive monthly payments.

AS level and A level cross-phase bundles

If a student chooses AS level subjects alongside other A level subject choices, the AS subjects can be included when bundling.

One of the most common combinations is 3 full A levels and 1 AS level. The cost for this would be £5,230 (£1,470 x 3 + £820).
